



Open Education System:

The Open Education System, with its over 1 million active students and approximately 3.5 million graduates, is the largest university offering open education opportunities in Türkiye. In addition to providing higher education through open and distance learning, it also plays a significant role in overcoming education challenges in Türkiye through special projects.

Foreign national students interested in studying at our university can also apply for the programs offered by the Open Education Faculty.



Admission Requirements for Foreign National Students:

Foreign national students who wish to study at Anadolu University at the associate degree/undergraduate level within formal/open education programs may apply based on:

- Exam for Foreign Students for Higher Education in Türkiye (TR-YÖS)
- Higher Education Entrance and Placement Exam for the Admission of Foreign Nationals to the Associate/Undergraduate Programmes of Anadolu University (ANADOLU YÖS)
- Exam Results with International Validity
- Diploma Grade

Situated right in the center of Eskişehir, which is well-known as a city of science, culture, and youth, its campus houses 12 faculties (undergraduate level) - three of which offer distance education, 3 applied schools - one of which is of music and drama, 3 vocational schools (associate level), 1 graduate school (graduate and postgraduate level) and 25 research centers including Turkish Teaching Application and Research Center (TÖMER).



Yunus Emre Campus is one of the greenest campuses in the world, with an area of 866 thousand 751 square meters. On the campus, you'll find a variety of social facilities alongside cafes where you can enjoy coffee or have a meal with friends. The campus also offers open and indoor sports areas for your convenience and recreation.



The university provides students with three meals a day (breakfast+lunch+dinner). Students must make reservations through the dining hall's website to benefit from this service. Meal service is offered with two menu options: vegetarian and regular.



The central library, with access to over 325,000 printed sources and numerous e-resources, allows students to explore a wealth of knowledge. Open 24 hours a day, including holidays, the library ensures uninterrupted student access. Also, students are offered free soup/tea/coffee between 00:00-01:00 in the library area. Spread across an area of 12,330 m², the central library provides students with various environments suitable for their study preferences.



Within the Yunus Emre Campus, there are three sports facilities: the Anadolu Sports Center, the Yunus Emre Campus Sports Hall, and Çarşı A Sports Facilities. These facilities offer services such as saunas, workouts, and gymnastics. The campus also provides opportunities for sports activities such as volleyball, basketball, table tennis, soccer, swimming, and tennis.
