ISTANBUL AIRPORT

From Istanbul Airport to Esenler Bus Terminal:

- You can take the M11 Metro line from Kağıthane and transfer first at M2 Mecidiyeköy, then at Yenikapı to M1A or M1B.
- During certain hours, you can also take IETT buses for a 1-2 hour trip.
- Additionally, HAVAIST passenger shuttle services operate hourly from the terminal building.

From Istanbul Airport to High-Speed Train (YHT) Söğütlüçeşme Station:

- From Istanbul Airport, take the metro to Kağıthane, then change lines to reach Mecidiyeköy. Next, transfer from metro to metrobüs at Mecidiyeköy and travel to Söğütlüçeşme.

➤ There are regular trips from ESENLER Bus Terminal and YHT Station to Eskişehir every hour during the day.



ISTANBUL SABIHA GÖKÇEN AIRPORT

- From Sabiha Gökçen Airport, take the M4 Kadıköy metro line to Ayrılık Çeşmesi stop, then transfer to Marmaray to reach Söğütlüçeşme YHT Station.



Türkiye

The Republic of Türkiye is a country located mainly in Anatolia with a small portion extending into the southeastern part of the Balkan Peninsula known as Thrace.

- It is surrounded by seas on three sides.
- It consists of 81 provinces. The capital city is Ankara. Some major cities are Istanbul, Ankara, Izmir, and Bursa. According to current data, the population is 85 million. The currency is the Turkish lira (TL).
- The official language of Türkiye is Turkish. Its alphabet consists of 29 letters. Turkish is an agglutinative language, and it is possible to derive many words from a simple word root.
- Türkiye is a secular country where the majority of the population is Muslim. In Türkiye, everyone has freedom to belong to their preferred religion and practice their worship.



The climate in Türkiye varies according to region. An overall temperate climate prevails throughout the country.



Türkiye is one of the world's most important tourist destinations. In addition to numerous tourist sites reflecting Türkiye's history and culture, the Mediterranean and Aegean coasts host hundreds of thousands of tourists worldwide, especially during the summer months. In recent years, the country has also become popular for health tourism.



Global companies such as Turkcell, Vodafone, and Türk Telekom provide mobile phone services. There are two options: postpaid and prepaid lines.



Credit cards such as VISA, MasterCard, and American Express are widely accepted for purchasing goods and services. There are ATMs from various banks and branches of some banks (TEB, Vakıfbank, Ziraat Bankası, and Türkiye İş bankası) on the Anadolu University campus.



In Istanbul, there are two airports: Sabiha Gökçen Airport (on the Anatolian side, East) and Istanbul New Airport (on the European side, West). Additionally, 59 civilian airports are in many cities nationwide, including Antalya Airport in Antalya, Adnan Menderes Airport in Izmir, and Esenboğa Airport in Ankara. The most frequently used and easiest routes are as follows:



ANTALYA

From Antalya Airport to Antalya Bus Terminal:

- Throughout the day, municipal buses operate every half hour. The scheduled trips from the terminal building take about 55-60 minutes on average.
 - Additionally, HAVAŞ passenger shuttle services operate from the terminal building every hour.
- From Antalya Bus Terminal, you can travel to Eskişehir by intercity buses.



ANKARA

From Esenboğa Airport to High-Speed Train (YHT) Station and AŞTİ Bus Terminal:

- Throughout the day, municipal buses called "EGO" depart every half hour from the terminal building. Trips take an average of 75-95 minutes.
 - Additionally, HAVAŞ and BELKAIR passenger shuttle services operate from the terminal building every hour.
- There are hourly trips from AŞTİ Bus Terminal and YHT Station to Eskişehir.
